

【Undergraduate】 Diploma Distribution Venue

1. After the Graduation Ceremony, please proceed to the venues listed below to receive your diploma, final transcript, and graduation certificate.

Note: The "Time" listed is an estimate for when to gather at each venue (classroom) after the graduation ceremony at Tucker Hall concludes.

2. Diplomas will be exchanged for your Student ID card. You must bring your Student ID. If you forget your Student ID, the certificate cannot be issued.

3. For graduates of the Teacher Training Course, Curator Course, Librarian Course, or Adult and Community Education Director Course:

"Education Staff Certificates" or "Completion Certificates" will be distributed until 18:00 at the Certification Courses Office (Building 2, 1st Floor).

(Note: Students of the Department of Education will receive these documents at their specific Diploma Distribution Venue).

4. On-the-day Sales of Graduation Albums:

For those who pre-purchased: The album will be mailed sequentially to the address provided at the time of order.

For those who did not pre-purchase: A limited number of copies will be sold on-site at the Building 11 Piloti on the following dates:

March 24 (Tue): 11:00 – 18:00 (Ends when sold out)

March 25 (Wed): 9:00 – 18:00 (Ends when sold out)

5. Video of the Graduation Ceremony at Tucker Hall:

In addition to the live stream, a recorded video of the ceremony is scheduled to be released on the University website starting in late April (available for one year).
